Digital Lifelines 2nd Annual Conference

The Digital Lifelines Scotland Programme is a collaboration between the Digital Health & Care Innovation Centre (DHI), Scottish Government, Scottish Drug Deaths Taskforce, Drugs Research Network Scotland (DRNS), Connecting Scotland, Technology Enabled Care (TEC), Scottish Council for Voluntary Organisations (SCVO), Convention of Scottish Local Authorities (COSLA) and the Simon Community Scotland.

The Programme is gathering significant momentum and has supported over 1,100 people at risk of drug-related death or harm to date.

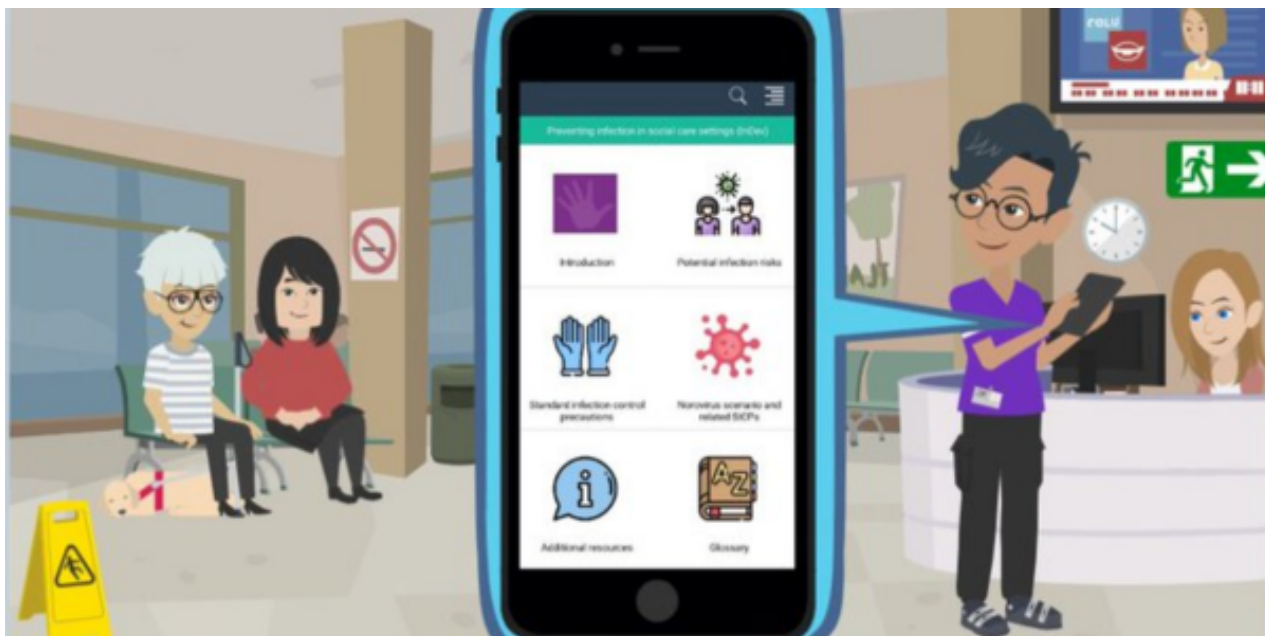

Infection Prevention & Control App launch

Health and social care staff will always have the latest infection prevention and control (IPC) guidance in their pocket thanks to a new app launched on Monday 24 July 2023.

The preventing infection in social care settings app was developed in partnership between the Scottish Social Services Council (SSSC), NHS Education for Scotland (NES) and the Digital Health & Care Innovation Centre (DHI).

Developed specifically for the social care workforce, the app builds on existing knowledge and good practice and enables workers to have national guidance at their fingertips when they need it.

Welcoming the launch, Minister for Social Care, Mental Wellbeing and Sport Maree Todd MSP said: ‘The app is a great example of collaborative working to develop a user-friendly resource for social care staff, ensuring the latest infection prevention and control guidance is at their fingertips. I am pleased to see that this app has been shaped by social care staff to support and enhance their practice and ultimately improve care for people they support.’

A ten-year plan to help create world-class entrepreneurial campuses at 45 universities and colleges across Scotland has been launched by the First Minister.

Strengthening global networks and supporting more university start-up businesses is among a raft of actions in The Entrepreneurial Campus plan - aimed at inspiring entrepreneurial thinking and improving enterprise skills.

A £5.5 million increase in the 2023-24 University Innovation Fund will help universities deliver the blueprint and Scotland's National Innovation Strategy while backing their wider efforts to turn world-leading research into important innovations.
