Collaboration in Research: Immersive Tech in Mental Health Webinar: 04 June, 11:00am–12:00pm

Develop a comprehensive digital strategy that encompasses all stages of the process, including pre-diagnosis and post-diagnosis.

Establish a coordinated approach among existing key workstreams, ensuring they are clearly defined, thoroughly documented, and accessible in a central repository to create a clear understanding of ongoing activities.

Assess the current landscape to identify gaps in services or resources and

determine where digital innovative solutions can be implemented to address those gaps.

Identify the immediate actions that can be taken, building on existing projects such as Redstar and ongoing efforts in Lothian.

Develop a long-term strategic plan that addresses broader objectives and ensures sustained progress.

9 1. UKRI: Innovate UK Investor Partnerships: SME round seven

UK-registered SMEs can apply for grant funding alongside private investment from selected investor partners.

Most of the funding for the Future Economy Investor Partnership programme has now been fully committed. The only specific themes with remaining funding available are:

Health and wellbeing

- Advancing life-changing cancer therapeutics, focussed on immunotherapies and paediatric oncology (Cancer Therapeutics)

-The application of extended reality for digital mental health, including immersive content that could be delivered as a digital mental health therapeutic in formal healthcare settings (Mindset)

Next generation digital technologies

- Projects within the creative industries which are underpinned by innovative digital technology as well as sustainable innovations, such as circular fashion (Creative Catalyst)

Innovate UK, part of UK Research and Innovation, is offering up to 50 Women in Innovation Awards to women entrepreneurs within SMEs across the UK. The winners will receive a £75,000 grant and bespoke business support.
